Saturday October 1	Depart Home City	Arrive – <b>Boston, Mass.</b> –get ready for a journey through the tranquil beauty of New England. Overnight Boston downtown for exploration, visit to the Faneuil Hall Marketplace, or maybe a lobster dinner?.
Sunday October 2	<b>Boston to Woodstock then Stowe, VT</b>  Overnight 2 nights at the <b>Stowe Mountain Lodge</b>	Set out for Vermont, the “ <b>Green Mountain State.</b> ” Traditional white steepled churches, quaint villages and tree-covered mountainsides dot the charming landscape of your journey. In <b>Woodstock</b> , a covered bridge in the town center, along with the beautifully restored Georgian houses that surround the town green, add credence to its reputation as “the quintessential New England village.” Visit the impressive 165' deep, mile-long <b>Quechee Gorge</b> before continuing to <b>Stowe for a two-night stay at this amazing Lodge!</b>

Monday October 3	<b>STOWE, Vermont</b>	We are surrounded by picturesque landscapes and orchards - watch apples transform into cider the old-fashioned way – using a rack and cloth press – during a trip to the <b>Cold Hollow Cider Mill</b> . A tour of <b>Ben &amp; Jerry's Ice Cream Factory</b> teaches you about the ice cream process and ends with a delicious sample of their sweet treats. This afternoon, enjoy time at leisure to just enjoy lovely Stowe and the Lodge.
Tuesday October 4	<b>Stowe – to North Conway, New Hampshire</b>  Overnight 2 nts. at the <b>Red Jacket's Resort Inn</b>	Soak in the lovely New England countryside as you journey through the <b>White Mountains</b> of New Hampshire to <b>North Conway</b> . Enroute, visit the <b>Rocks Estate</b> , home to the North Country Conservation & Education Center. Tour the farm and learn about the history and importance of <b>maple sugaring</b> in the region, including a visit to a virtual tap room.
Wednesday October 5	<b>North Conway - Lake Winnepesaukee - North Conway</b>	Begin the day with a visit to New Hampshire's <b>picturesque lakes region</b> , a popular vacation spot for visitors year-round. Board the M/S Mount Washington and spend the next hour <b>cruising stunning Lake Winnepesaukee</b> , New Hampshire's largest lake. After your cruise, visit the <b>charming town of Wolfboro</b> , the " <b>oldest summer resort in America</b> ." Later, return to North Conway via the <b>Kancamagus Highway</b> , a scenic byway offering spectacular views of the White Mountains region.
Thursday October 6	<b>North Conway - Boothbay Harbor, Maine</b>  Overnight at the <b>Spruce Point Inn Resort &amp; Spa</b>	Depart New Hampshire for Maine, arriving in beautiful <b>Boothbay Harbor</b> , the " <b>boating capital of New England</b> ." View the rugged coastline on a drive along <b>picturesque Ocean Point Road</b> . Enjoy a relaxing <b>cruise through Boothbay Harbor</b> for spectacular views of the coast, including lighthouses, summer homes and even local wildlife, such as the harbor seals. Learn about New England's <b>lobster industry</b> and watch as a lobster trap is pulled aboard the boat to view the day's catch. Tonight, join your fellow travelers for a very special farewell <b>dinner featuring the fresh native lobster</b> for which coastal Maine is renowned.
Friday October 7	<b>Boothbay Harbor - Kennebunkport – Providence-New Haven</b>	Travel through the seaside community of <b>Kennebunkport</b> , along <b>spectacular Ocean Drive</b> . See <b>Walker's Point</b> , former President George H. W. Bush's summer home, which is situated on a rocky promontory. Overnight Providence-New Haven.
Saturday October 8	<b>Providence-New Haven To New York City</b>	Finish the tour at New York City, and fly home - or since you're already here – join the Pauls for a 7 nt. Canada-New England scenic cruise on the <b>Regal Princess</b> . See special flyer for details.
