

Saturday October 1	Depart Home City Royal Sonesta Cambridge	Arrive – Boston, Mass. –get ready for a journey through the tranquil beauty of New England. Overnight Boston after enjoying a dinner at a favorite local restaurant. (D)
Sunday October 2	Boston to Lake Winnepesaukee then North Conway Overnight 2 nights At the Grand Hotel – North Conway, NH	Start the day with a sightseeing tour that includes the Old South Meeting House, Public Gardens, Old North Church and Beacon Hill. Stop at the famed Faneuill Market Hall. Later, set out for New Hampshire and a visit to the picturesque lakes region , a popular vacation spot for visitors year-round. Board the M/S Mount Washington and spend the next hour cruising stunning Lake Winnepesaukee , New Hampshire's largest lake. After your cruise, visit the charming town of Wolfeboro, the “oldest

		summer resort in America.” Overnight North Conway. (B)
Monday October 3	North Conway Overnight Grand Hotel	Soak in the lovely New England countryside as you journey travel the Kancamagus Highway through the White Mountains of New Hampshire. Enroute, visit the Rocks Estate , home to the North Country Conservation & Education Center. Tour the farm and learn about the history and importance of maple sugaring in the region, including a visit to a virtual tap room. (B,D)
Tuesday October 4	North Conway to Woodstock, VT to Burlington Doubletree Hilton Overnight (2 nts)	Set out for Vermont, the “ Green Mountain State. ” Traditional white steeple churches, quaint villages and tree-covered mountainsides dot the charming landscape of your journey. In Woodstock , a covered bridge in the town center, along with the beautifully restored Georgian houses that surround the town green, add credence to its reputation as “the quintessential New England village.” Visit the impressive 165' deep, mile-long Quechee Gorge before continuing to Burlington for a two-night stay. (B)
Wednesday October 5	Stowe – Burlington area Doubletree Hilton overnight	We are surrounded by picturesque landscapes and orchards - watch apples transform into cider the old-fashioned way – using a rack and cloth press – during a trip to the Cold Hollow Cider Mill . A tour of Ben & Jerry’s Ice Cream Factory teaches you about the ice cream process and ends with a delicious sample of their sweet treats. This afternoon, enjoy time at leisure to just enjoy lovely Stowe and the area. (B)
Thursday October 6	Burlington - Boothbay Harbor, Maine - Portland Overnight at the Westin Harborview - Portland	Depart Vermont for Maine, arriving in beautiful Boothbay Harbor, the “boating capital of New England.” View the rugged coastline on a drive along picturesque Ocean Point Road . Enjoy a relaxing cruise through Boothbay Harbor for spectacular views of the coast, including lighthouses, summer homes and even local wildlife, such as the harbor seals. Learn about New England’s lobster industry and watch as a lobster trap is pulled aboard the boat to view the day’s catch. Tonight, join your fellow travelers for a very special dinner (B, D)
Friday October 7	Portland - Kennebunkport to Providence-New Haven Overnight Hilton Providence	Travel through the seaside community of Kennebunkport , along spectacular Ocean Drive . See Walker’s Point , former President George H. W. Bush’s summer home, which is situated on a rocky promontory. Farewell dinner on historic Federal Hill- Providence. (B,D)
Saturday October 8	Providence-New Haven To New York City	Finish the tour in Providence, and fly home - or since you’re already here – join the Pauls for a 7 nt. Canada-New England scenic cruise on the Regal Princess from New York . See special flyer for details. (B)
